As a member of the AIS West senior leadership team, the Assistant Principal works with the Director and other members of the leadership team to formulate the school's strategic plans and programs. As a member of the Elementary School leadership team the Assistant Principal supports the Principal with the day-to-day operations of the Elementary School. As a collaborative and welcoming school leader, the Assistant Principal will also make meaningful contributions toward building a strong sense of community and positive culture within the school.

This position begins on August 1, 2024.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide direction and support in the review, development, and implementation of the curriculum plan and ensure that it is in accordance with the guidelines and parameters established.
- Work with other members of the senior leadership team to ensure compliance with all MSA authorization requirements
- Assist with the development and administration of policies dealing with discipline, conduct, and attendance
- Take a positive and proactive approach to student academic, behavioral, and emotional development
- Assist with the development of timetables, schedules, and procedures/protocols to ensure the effective delivery of educational services
- Review professional growth plans and conduct teacher evaluations as needed
- Model and reinforce best pedagogical practice both within and outside of the classroom.
- Identify teacher training needs and assist with the planning and delivery of professional development activities in accordance with the school's curriculum plan and pedagogical and assessment frameworks
- Assist with the development of assessment and reporting procedures and proof and edit reports as required
- Assist with the development of the orientation program for new and returning faculty
- Assist with Parent Information Sessions and help parents achieve a clear understanding of the nature of the program
- Create, lead or oversee relevant school committees
- Assist with the recruitment of faculty as required.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Elementary School Principal.

The School

Curriculum

For High School students the option of the IB DP is available that culminates in awarding eligible students either an American High School Diploma or the International Baccalaureate Diploma. The curriculum is designed to prepare students for entry into highly competitive colleges in the United States, Canada, Europe, the Middle East, and elsewhere.

Organization and Governance

The Director and each of the school's 3 Principals report to the Board, which is composed of members of the Esol leadership team. The Esol leadership team, along with its Chief Information Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Education Consultants, and others, provide support to AIS - West and other Esol schools in their respective areas of expertise.

AIS West is part of the Esol Education group of schools. Operating since 1976, Esol Education is an organization specialized in the establishment and management of high-quality international schools. Esol currently operates schools in Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Bahrain, Egypt, Cyprus, Hong Kong and Lebanon.

Campus and Facilities

The school's expansive, well-equipped campus includes two libraries, media centers, science labs, as well as spacious drama and music studios, and a 500-seat auditorium which hosts assemblies, school concerts and theater productions. The athletics complex includes a large indoor gymnasium, two shaded and heated swimming pools, a soccer field and a running track. These offer ample opportunities for students to develop their physical skills, incorporate wellness, and participate in inter school athletic competitions.

Cairo Egypt

Cairo is a vibrant, fascinating and welcoming city. Home to many of the best Pharaonic, Coptic and Islamic sites in Egypt, it is a city where you never know what incredible, half-forgotten monument you might stumble upon while wandering around town. Cairo residents can enjoy evenings on the Nile River, visits to the capital's medieval markets by Khan El-Khalili, and walks along the Nile promenade. There are also many remarkable museums, art galleries, cinemas, theaters and modern malls. On any given week, one can attend an opera or enjoy oriental music dance shows, as well as see the Giza Pyramids and thousands of ancient artifacts at the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities.

The weather in Cairo is moderate with low humidity at almost any time of the year. Highs of 36°C are common in July and lows of 21°C have been witnessed. The winter months in Cairo are very pleasant with temperatures ranging between 15°C and 21°C.

Egypt offers fantastic opportunities for domestic travel to the beaches and coral reefs of Sinai and the Red Sea coast, and incredible ancient historical sites like the ancient temples and the Valley of Kings in Luxor. Opportunities for international travel are also excellent thanks to Cairo's proximity to some of the world's best tourist destinations in Europe, the Middle East, and Africa.
